The American Public Works Association – North Carolina Chapter will be awarding \$2,000 scholarship(s) to deserving student(s) in North Carolina. This program will assist students in attaining their career aspirations and building a foundation of future public works leaders.

Eligibility: Students must be enrolled as a full-time student in a North Carolina University or NC Technical College continuing education program in a public works related curriculum (includes classes in public works, public administration, engineering, business, science or similar programs) and participate in a student chapter or other organization that demonstrates commitment to the public works profession. Must obtain a minimum of a “3.0” grade average, and have taken the class in the prior/current school year. Preference is giving to rising juniors or seniors in a Bachelor’s or Master’s program not graduating before December of the present year. In order for a previous APWA scholarship winner to be considered for a second year, the student must have worked during school or the summer in the public works field.
